There will be no in-person church during the month of January. A decision was made at the Green Lake Church Board meeting January 18 to resume in-person church services Sabbath February 5. On-line worship services will continue on YouTube. The decision to resume was not unanimous as there remains significant risk for the most vulnerable people, infection rates remain high; the infection can be passed on by symptomatic and asymptomatic people as well as vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals. The church board advises caution as each person makes his or her own decision in regards to risk. Evidence shows that vaccination plus a booster is the best way to prevent serious infection due to SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19). Long COVID symptoms are still a concern with the omicron variant. The use of N-95 masks or masks with similar protection is encouraged for those who attend the in-person services. Some N-95 masks will be available at Green Lake Church in February. Eye protection is encouraged. **Church volunteers: because of anxiety and uncertainty at this stage of the pandemic, we strongly support any decision to stay away from in-person services. Older individuals, individuals with increased risk for serious infections, and anyone else anxious about this phase of the pandemic: you are encouraged to continue online interaction with green lake church.**
